90+ million pounds of surplus fruits and vegetables have been diverted from landfills and donated to people experiencing food insecurity since 2009



Since 2009, Food Forward's programs resulted in:

34,106 metric tons of CO₂ equivalent prevented = **7,215 cars** taken off the road for a year

Food Forward is the only nonprofit organization to win a Food Recovery Challenge Award from the U.S. EPA for the prevention and diversion of wasted food

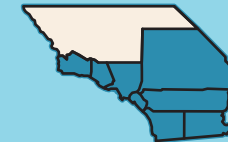
